## Let your light shine

### Family

#### I/we will

- Be polite and respectful to everyone in our school community (children, staff, parents, visitors and governors)
- Make sure that my child attends school and on time (8.50am), providing an explanation if absent.
- Not take my child on holiday during term time
- Ensure that my child wears the St Catherine's uniform, including correct kit on P.E. days
- Make the teacher aware of any concerns or problems that may affect my child's learning or behaviour in school
- Support the school behaviour and anti bullying policy and encourage my child to follow the school rules
- Be part of my child's learning journey by;
- Attending family conferencing meetings as well as other relevant meetings/curriculum workshops
- Support my child with their home learning and reading
- Read regularly with my child to promote a love of reading as often as possible but at least 3 times per week
- Support the school approach to online safety (see pupil section) and not deliberately upload or add any images, sounds or text that could upset or offend any member of the school community (if in doubt, please check)
- Help my child stay safe with the SMART online safety rules and ensure that they only sign up to age-appropriate apps and platforms and games
- Support our Christian ethos, our school rules and our half termly values
- Endeavour to support the School and its' fundraising and other activities for the school

## Pupil

- Be ready, respectful and safe at all times

- Attend school unless I am ill and arrive on time
- Follow our online safety rules and use only ageappropriate social media sites, games and apps

- Wear correct school uniform and P.E. kit
- Help to look after our school and respect school property
- Look after school equipment and come to school ready for the day; PE kits, book bags and reading books
- Apply the school learning behaviours and try my best in learning
- Read regularly with an adult at home (at least 3 times a week but hopefully more!)
- Try to tell adults how I am feeling
